

Aquila Club Frequently Asked Questions

How to book your swim?

- You will need to pre-book your swim with our leisure centre.
- We ask all our guests to book over the phone to avoid queuing at the leisure centre.
- A swim can be booked on arrival from your hotel room or apartment by ringing ext. 7220 or our direct line 064 6636178.
- You can book your swim one day in advance or on the morning of the day you would like to swim.

How long is your swim session?

- You can book an hour swim session for you or your family. The first session begins at 8am and hourly thereafter.
- This includes 45 minutes of pool usage and 15 minutes for entry and exit of the leisure centre.

Can I use changing facilities?

- We ask all our guests where practical to change before coming to the leisure centre.
- There will be limited changing facilities available to use but unfortunately our shower and locker facilities will not be available.

Where can I shower, and do you provide towels?

- Due to Covid-19 restrictions, we kindly ask all our guests to shower in their rooms post swim as our changing room showers are unavailable.
- We kindly ask all guests to use the towels provided in their room as we will not be providing towels in the leisure centre.

Can I shower before using the pool?

- Yes, we do have pre-swim shower facilities available.

Do I have to wear a swim hat in the pool?

- Yes, swim hats are compulsory in our pool.
- If you require a swim hat, we sell them at the leisure centre for €3.

What are the opening hours of the Aquila Club Leisure Centre?

- 8am – 9pm daily and family hours finish at 8pm.

What are the opening hours for outdoor activities?

- Outdoor facilities are open from 10am – 9pm Monday to Sunday. Weather permitting.

Do you supply Boards and Woggles?

- Due to Covid-19 restrictions we cannot provide boards and woggles.
- Swimming aids such as armbands and goggles can be purchased from the Aquila Club reception.

Is the adult only area opened in the pool?

- Yes, it will be opened for limited hours and social distancing protocols must be adhered to.

Where can I get a copy of the kid's club programme?

- Main Reception or Aquila Club Reception.

Do I need to supervise my child in the water?

- All children under the age of 14 must be accompanied in the water by a parent.
- All children between the ages of 14 – 16 must have an adult supervising from the viewing area.
- Ratio of 1 adult to 4 children.
